🏠 Before Your Appointment

Prepare your home to help our experts work efficiently:

- 1. Clear spaces Remove bedding, pillows, and clutter from around beds, sofas, and carpets.
- 2. Bag delicate items Place stuffed toys, blankets, and fabrics in plastic bags for post-service washing.
- Open blinds & clear window sills Clover mites gather on sunny windows; clearing helps treatment access.
- 4. Exterior prep Trim grass and plants touching your home's foundation; keep a small gravel strip around edges.
- 5. Pets & aquariums Keep pets away during treatment. Cover fish tanks and turn off air pumps until areas are dry.
- 6. Vacuum floors and window sills lightly before the visit to reduce loose dust and allergens.

During the Service

What to expect while we work:

- 1. **Inspection first** We focus on bedrooms, upholstery, window sills, and other mite-prone zones.
- 2. Stay out of treated areas until surfaces are completely dry (usually 2–4 hours).
- 3. No bedding spray We never treat bedding directly; cleaning and heat treatment are safer and more effective.



Lock in long-term results with simple weekly habits:

- 1. Wash bedding weekly in hot water (130°F / 54°C) Sheets, blankets, and pillowcases.
- 2. Dry on high heat for at least 15 minutes before regular drying to kill mites and eggs.
- 3. Use zippered encasements on pillows and mattresses to trap and block dust mites.
- 4. **HEPA vacuum weekly** Focus on carpets, mattresses, upholstery, and window sills.
- 5. **Keep humidity below 50%** using air conditioning or dehumidifiers.
- 6. Avoid dry dusting Use damp cloths to prevent mites and allergens from becoming airborne.
- 7. **Soft toys & fabrics** Wash weekly on hot or tumble-dry on high for at least 15 minutes.
- 8. Vacuum (don't smear) any clover mites you see; crushed mites may stain walls.
- 9. **Seal exterior gaps and cracks** to prevent re-entry from clover or bird mites.

Ongoing Maintenance Tips

- Maintain your weekly wash + HEPA vacuum routine.
- Inspect window sills and corners monthly for new mite activity.
- Check and re-seal tiny foundation cracks each season.
- **Trim vegetation** near your home to limit outdoor mite migration.

Safety Reminders

- Always follow **product label directions** for re-entry times.
- Wait until treated areas are arid before returning.
- If fogging was performed, ventilate rooms after 2-4 hours before reoccupying.

• Keep children and pets out of treated areas until you're told it's safe.

Pro Tip from Perfect Pest:
